Abraham Bird Sr. 1756-1820	s/o Mounce Bird 1735-1793	Certain: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR – large tomb	Elevated, damaged tomb still exists, but not proven he is still there; Rev War Captain
Elizabeth Vail 11 May 1820-10 Jan 1823 (31 Mos.)	d/o Samuel Vail & Mary Bird 1794-1848	Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	See “Who is in the Tiny Cast Iron Casket in Bird Cemetery, East Baton Rouge Parish?”; Has not been located in any other cemetery.
William Thompson Bird 1784-1830	s/o Abraham Sr.	Very Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Two matching, broken, engraved ledger stone fragments (“W.T.”) at Hollywood - likely his; grave not been located in any other cemetery.
John Thompson Bird Oct 1840- 11 Aug 1842 (19 Mos.)	s/o Thompson William Bird (s/o Abraham Bird Jr) & Artemisa Esnard	Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	See “Who is in the Tiny Cast Iron Casket in Bird Cemetery, East Baton Rouge Parish?”; Has not been located in any other cemetery.
Mary Bowie 04 May 1792-19 Aug 1842	w/o Abraham Jr	Certain: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Marker is displaced, but exists; Has not been located in any other cemetery
Mary Bird 1794-1848	d/o Abraham Bird Sr.	Very Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Broken engraved stone at Hollywood is likely hers; Has not been located in any other cemetery.
Samuel Vail 1788-1848	h/o Mary Bird (above)	Possible: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Has not been located in any other cemetery.
Thompson Bird Feb 1849-Dec 1849 (10 Mos.)	s/o Thompson William Bird (s/o Abraham Bird Jr. & Artemisa Esnard)	Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR; Likely the occupant of the “Tiny Cast Iron Casket” inside the tomb.	See “Who was in the Tiny Cast Iron Casket in Bird Cemetery, East Baton Rouge Parish?”; Has not been located in any other cemetery.
Nancy Black 1786-08 Sep 1850	w/o W.T. Bird (above)	Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Has not been located in any other cemetery.
Margaret Bird Btw. 1782-1796-15 Jun 1854	d/o Abraham Bird Sr.	Very Likely: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Never married. Lived at Hollywood Plantation with brother, Abraham Jr., at death. Has not been located in any other cemetery.
Abraham Bird Jr. 17 Sep 1784-15 Oct 1860	s/o Abraham Sr.	Certain: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	Marker is displaced, but exists; Has not been located in any other cemetery; War of 1812
Abraham John Bird (1837-09 Jun 1861	s/o Thompson William Bird	Certain: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, EBR	A CSA marker at Camp Moore Confederate Cemetery, Tangipahoa Parish. Newspaper records indicate burial at Hollywood Plantation
Mary Caroline Bird Apr 1818-27 Jul 1879	d/o Abraham Bird Jr. & Mary Bowie	Certain: Bird Cemetery, Hollywood Plantation, East Baton Rouge Parish	Marker is displaced but exists; Has not been located in any other cemetery.

Mary Hill Bird 06 Jun 1849-21 Jun 1852	d/o John A Bird	Bird Cemetery, then, reinterred at Magnolia Cemetery, East Baton Rouge Parish (ca. 1900)	Marker in Magnolia Cemetery
John Abraham Bird Feb 1816- Sep 1866	s/o Abraham Bird Jr	Bird Cemetery, then, reinterred at Magnolia Cemetery, East Baton Rouge Parish (ca. 1900)	Marker in Magnolia Cemetery
